Dear Mayor and Board of Supervisors:

Please find attached a copy of our annual report for the Regional Floodplain Management Plan.

Regional Floodplain Management Plan" was adopted by five counties in 2008. Each county has the potential to impact downstream communities, making flooding a watershed-wide challenge. The main goal of the Regional Plan to develop strategies for floodplain management that can be applied watershed wide as well as locally. Included in the Plan are suggested actions that encourage communities within the Carson River Watershed to recognize the value and critical functions provided by floodplain lands for public safety and reduction of costly flood damages. And suggested actions also address the need for accurate data, reduction of negative impacts from existing infrastructure, and outreach and education.

This Plan is intended to be a starting point and a living document that guides the implementation of the suggested action
